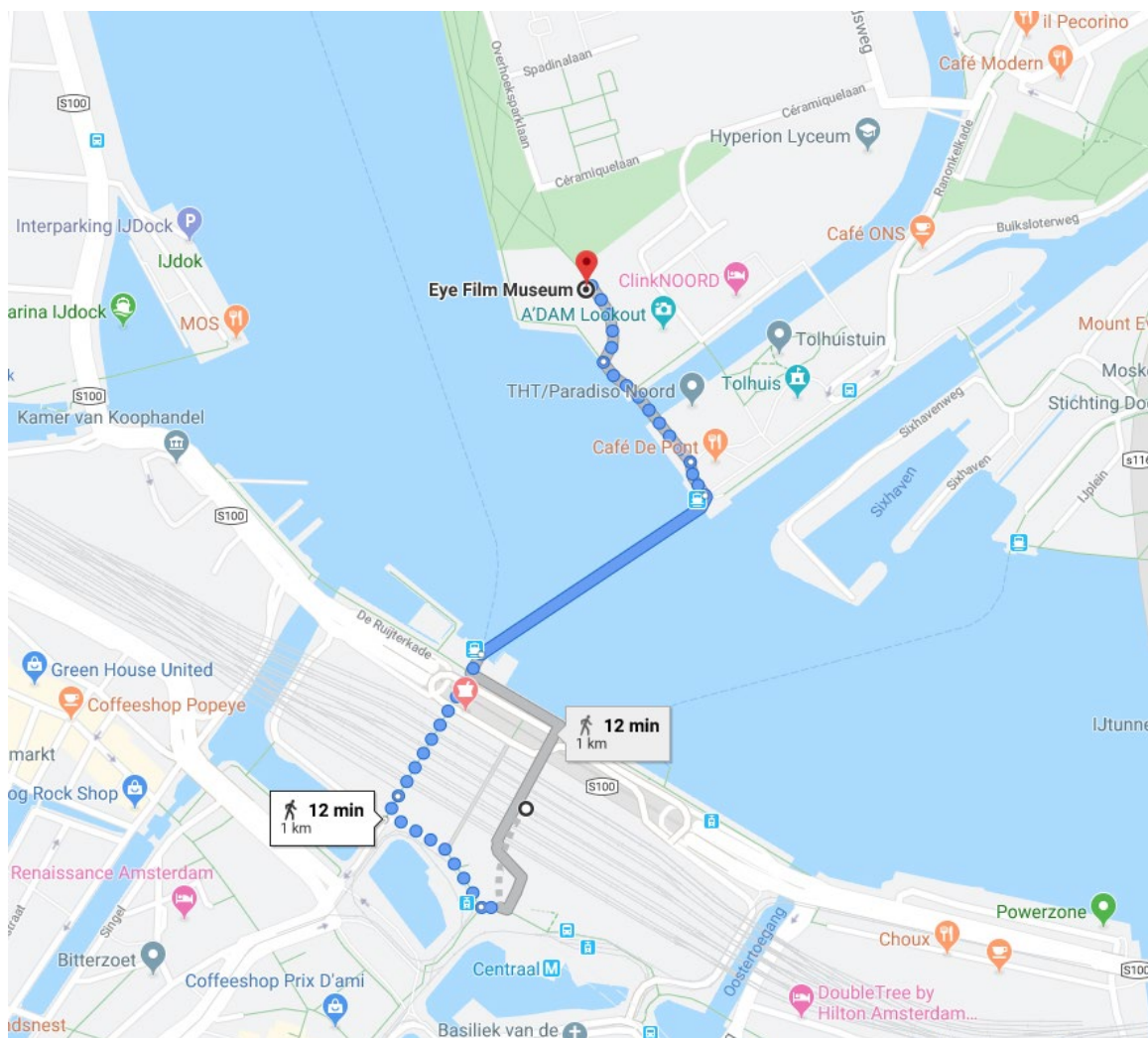
Eye Filmmuseum (IJpromenade 1)

Train

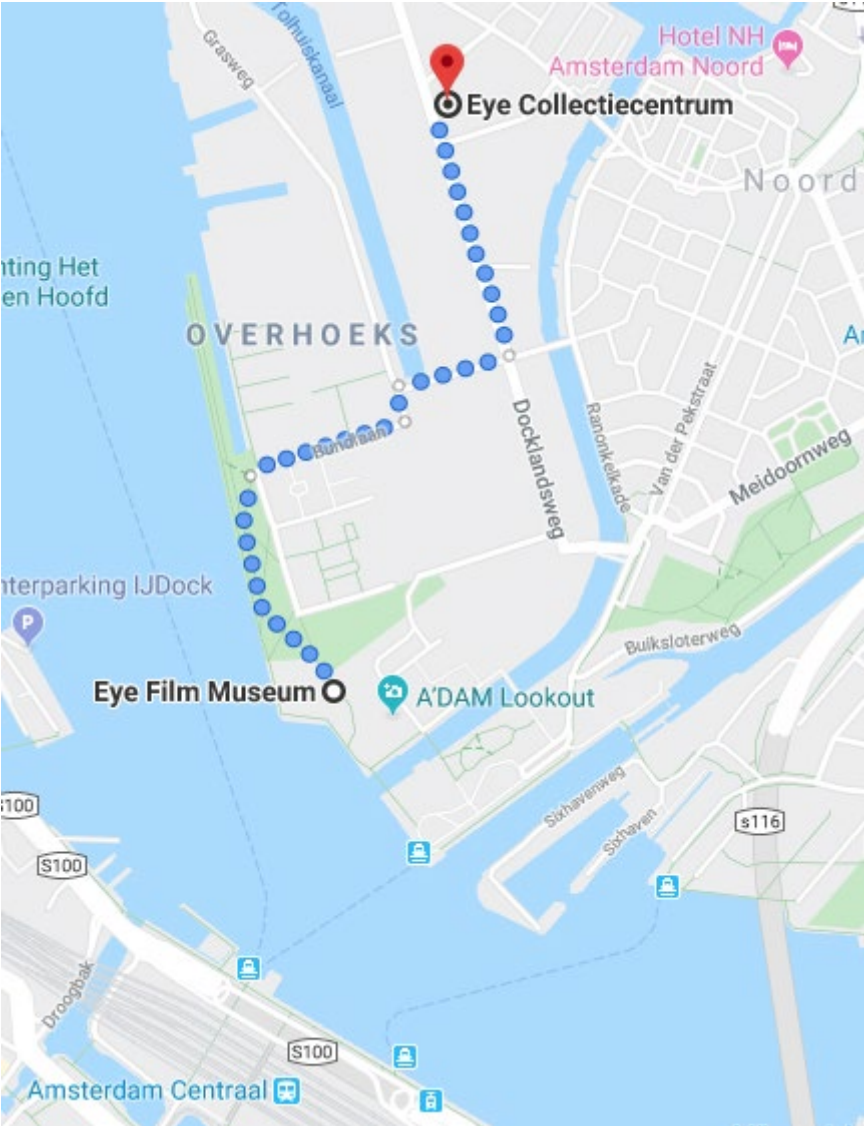
Eye is directly opposite Amsterdam Central Station. When arriving at Amsterdam Central Station, take the exit to IJzijde (IJ bank) to take a ferry.

Shuttle ferry

Take the ferry in the direction of Buiksloterweg. The 24/7 ferry service is free and leaves every few minutes. The ferry ride takes approximately three minutes. Eye is located on your left and is a three-minute walk as you arrive in Amsterdam Noord.
